

**Student Leader Elections 2019**  
**Terms & Conditions**

**Cash Prize Draw**

1. The prize draw is open from 7am, 5 March 2019  
The closing date for receipt of entries is 5pm, 6 March 2019  
A prize draw will take place on 11 March 2019
2. 1 x first prize consists of:  
£500 cash
3. 2 x runner up prizes consists of:  
£250 cash
4. To enter the prize draw, entrants must vote in the Student Leader Elections 2019, held from 7am, 5 March – 5pm, 6 March 2019. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website (<http://www.qubsu.org/>).
5. For your total confidence, the winners will be selected at random by an independent third party along with a list of reserve winners.
6. Winners will be notified via the QUB e-mail address details collected via the voting system. Winners should respond in the manner outlined and within the time specified in the e-mail to claim the prize. If a winner does not respond within the time specified we will award the prize to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. This process will be repeated until a winner redeems the prize. Should prize notification/s be returned as undeliverable we will award the prize/s to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.
7. Once the winners have redeemed the prize their names will be made available on the Queen's Students' Union's Facebook page and is available upon request by phoning the Queen's Students' Union Marketing Department on 028 90 97 1067 between 9am - 5pm Monday to Friday.

Entrants must: be over the age of eighteen on the closing date; reside in Northern Ireland during term time (except those who are otherwise eligible but due to a placement are residing outside of Northern Ireland during term time); and be a current member of Queen's Students' Union (St Mary's and Stranmillis students are not eligible). Queen's Students' Union reserves the right to request proof of age and sight of a valid Queen's University student card.
9. The prize draw excludes permanent employees and their immediate families of Queen's Students Union, Queen's University, Belfast, their agents or anyone professionally connected with this promotion.
