

Queen's Students' Union - SU Elections 2023

Terms & Conditions

Battle of the Halls - Open to students living in Queen's Accommodation

1. The competition is open from 12noon, Monday 6 March, 2023
The closing date for receipt of entries is 3pm, Thursday 9 March, 2023
2. The prize is: 1 x visit of an Ice Cream Van W/C 13 March 2023 or W/C 20 March 2023. Ice Creams, Ice Lollies & Slushies will be distributed to the value of approx. £500-£1000 depending on the winning QUB accommodation site.
3. To enter the prize draw, entrants must vote in the SU Elections 2023, held from 12noon, 6 March 2023 – 3pm, 9 March 2023. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website (<http://www.q-su.org/>).
4. Solely voting in the Clubs & Societies Committee Elections does **NOT** constitute voting in the SU Elections, and does not provide an entry to this competition.
5. The Accommodation Site with the highest percentage of votes upon close of voting will win the prize.

Entrants must: be over the age of eighteen on the closing date and be a current member of Queen's Students' Union (St Mary's and Stranmillis students are not eligible) and be a resident of Queen's Accommodation – those with paused contracts are eligible to vote but will not receive an equivalent prize as this is an onsite only prize. Queen's Students' Union reserves the right to request proof of age and sight of a valid Queen's University student card.
10. Students of Queen's-INTO are not eligible to vote.
11. Entries from third parties or agents or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made directly by the person entering the promotion.
12. Only one entry per person.
13. No purchase necessary.
