

## Queen's Students' Union - SU Elections 2023

### Terms & Conditions

#### Clubs & Societies Prize Contest

1. The competition is open from 12noon, Monday 6 March, 2023  
The closing date for receipt of entries is 3pm, Thursday 9 March, 2023
1. **TIER PRIZE CONTEST - 6 x £150 cash prizes** to be credited into the 'Own Funds' Account of the Club or Society (C&S) that secures the greatest total number of voting members in their tier of Club or Society in the 'SU Elections 2023' held from 12noon, Monday 6 March, 2023 – 3pm, Thursday 9 March, 2023. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website (<http://www.q-su.org/>).
  - Tiers are as follows:
    - **Tier 1** – 0-25 Members
    - **Tier 2** – 26-50 Members
    - **Tier 3** – 51-100 Members
    - **Tier 4** – 101-150 Members
    - **Tier 5** – 151-200 Members
    - **Tier 6** – 201+ Members

In the instance of more than one Club or Society having the same number of voting members in the same tier at the close of polling, the prize will be distributed equally.
2. **GRAND PRIZE CONTEST - 1 x £250 cash prize** to be credited into the 'Own Funds' Account of the Club or Society (C&S) that secures the greatest overall number of voting members in the SU Elections 2023 held from 12noon, Monday 6 March, 2023 – 3pm, Thursday 9 March, 2023. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website (<http://www.q-su.org/>).
3. Solely voting in the Clubs & Societies Committee Elections does **NOT** constitute voting in the SU Elections, and does not provide an entry to this competition.
4. A voting member is defined as a current Queen's student who has been formally added to a Club / Society's membership on the online C&S admin system in advance of polls opening. C&S committees are responsible for uploading their memberships to the online system. If any C&S experiences issues uploading their memberships, they should contact the SU on [su.societies@qub.ac.uk](mailto:su.societies@qub.ac.uk) in advance of polls opening.
5. Tier Prize - C&S are allocated into Tiers 1-6 according to their All Members total on the online admin system. The Club or Society that secures the greatest number of voting members in their tier will be notified via the C&S President's official email address by Thurs 16 March and the £150 prize will be allocated to the Club or Society 'Own Funds' account by 31 March 2023. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.
6. Grand Prize - The Club or Society that secures the greatest overall number of voting members will be notified via the C&S President's official email address by Thurs 16 March and the £250 prize will be allocated to the Club or Society 'Own Funds' account by 31 March 2023. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.

8. Entrants must: be over the age of eighteen on the closing date and be a current member of Queen's Students' Union (St Mary's and Stranmillis students are not eligible). Queen's Students' Union reserves the right to request proof of age and sight of a valid Queen's University student card.
9. The contest excludes permanent employees and their immediate families of Queen's Students Union, Queen's University, Belfast, their agents or anyone professionally connected with this promotion.
10. Students of Queen's-INTO are not eligible to vote.
11. Entries from third parties or agents or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All entries must be made directly by the person entering the promotion.
12. Only one entry per person.
