

QUB RAG Pub Crawl 2023 - Terms and Conditions

By partaking in the QUB RAG Pub Crawl on Thursday 21 September 2023, you the participant hereby agrees to the following Terms and Conditions:

General:

- QUB RAG Pub Crawl t-shirts act as entry tickets for the event and can only be sold to individuals aged 18 and over and who can present a QUB Student ID at the time of purchase.
- T-shirts sales are limited to a maximum of 5 per person.
- T-shirts are to be worn the entire duration (6pm – late) of the pub crawl since they act as entry tickets for and identifiers of event participants.
- The t-shirt price covers the tour but does NOT include any snacks or drinks purchased in the pubs which is entirely at your discretion.

Timings:

- A fixed start time applies to the QUB RAG Pub Crawl so you must arrive at the designated meeting place in good time.
- Participants will be allocated to a group with at least two team leaders who oversee the route, timings and all aspects relating to managing the crawl. Please follow their instructions at all times.

Access:

- Please bring photo ID in case you are asked to prove your age at any of the pubs being visited on the pub crawl route.
- Pubs have differing levels of disabled access both in terms of entrance and access to bathroom facilities.
- QUB RAG make every effort to ensure that the route is in line with pub opening times and visit times have been pre-agreed by pub management. QUB RAG cannot be held responsible if individual pubs on the route are closed or are barring entry to the pub for any reason.

Health & Safety:

- We expect customers who enter pubs on the crawl to purchase a drink, alcoholic or otherwise, however please don't pressure your team leaders to drink alcohol as they are not allowed to do so whilst co-ordinating your groups pub crawl.

- Individuals are responsible for drinking sensibly within the timeframe inside each pub and over the duration of the crawl.
- Individuals are responsible for their own health and safety on the crawl including negotiating footpaths & road crossings and inside pubs on the crawl. Participants requiring any additional assistance or special requirements are expected to inform QUB RAG prior to the crawl and advise on any assistance needed.
- QUB RAG is not responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to your personal property during the crawl. Individuals must take the usual precautions to safeguard their own valuables.
- All participants should be aware of their own physical or mental limitations before attending the Pub Crawl. Participants with relevant medical conditions or who are pregnant are strongly advised not to participate.

Behaviour:

- Courtesy and mutual respect are expected at all times. If the behaviour of any participant is aggressive, threatening, abusive, offensive or in any other way causes concern or distress to the Team Leaders, or other crawl members, bar staff or the public, the Team Leader can request that the customer amend their behaviour or ask them to leave the crawl immediately. Bar security intervention will be requested if necessary. No refunds will be made in such circumstances.
- Participants are responsible for their own behaviour and QUB RAG accept no responsibility for the adverse behaviour of crawl participants. Any action taken by pubs or others in response to the behaviour of crawl participants is deemed to be taken against the individual(s) concerned and not against QUB RAG. Should the behaviour of any individual result in either the individual or the group being asked to leave any pub, they will be deemed to have broken the terms of the agreement and will be asked to leave the crawl immediately, (unless there are reasonable mitigating circumstances). No refund will be provided.
- QUB RAG cannot be held responsible if enjoyment of the crawl has been adversely affected by the service, condition and facilities provided by individual pubs or the behaviour of their staff or customers. In such cases we would ask you to advise the Team Leader and/or contact us so that we can assess each case on its merits and any suitable redress.
- Similarly, QUB RAG cannot be held responsible if enjoyment of the crawl has been adversely affected by the behaviour of other crawl participants. In such cases we would ask you to advise the Team Leader and/or contact us so that we can assess whether further action is appropriate.

Please notify us in advance of photos/video being taken if you do not wish your image to be used in this way.

Cancellation:

- QUB RAG reserve the right to amend or cancel the pub crawl. In relation to cancellation by us, notice will be given via our social media channels and a full refund paid and the return of the pub crawl t-shirt. However, we can accept no further liability for any costs incurred as a result of cancellation.

Data Protection:

- QUB RAG will not process, store, or share any of your personal details with external groups, organisations, or individuals.
