

Queen's Students' Union – Win £200 – Vote for an Idea - Terms & Conditions

Cash Prize Draw – Open to All Students

1. Voting is open from 1pm, Monday 21 October, 2024.
The closing date for casting of votes is 8pm, Sunday 27 October, 2024
A prize draw will take place on Monday 28 October, 2024.
2. **1 x INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PRIZE CONSISTING OF £200 CASH.**
3. To enter the prize draw, entrants must vote for a student idea, held from 1pm, Monday 21 October 2024 to 8pm, Sunday 27 October, 2024. Votes can be cast via the Students' Union Website <https://home.q-su.org/voice/ideas/>.
4. To be eligible for the prize, the winner must hold a UK bank account in order for the prize money to be transferred.
5. For your total confidence, the winner of the individual student prize will be selected at random by an independent third party along with a list of reserve winners.
6. Winners will be notified via the QUB e-mail address details collected via the voting system. Winners should respond in the manner outlined and within the time specified in the e-mail to claim the prize. If a winner does not respond within the time specified we will award the prize to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. This process will be repeated until a winner redeems the prize. Should prize notification/s be returned as undeliverable we will award the prize/s to a substitute winner chosen at the same time as the original. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted.
7. Voters must: be over the age of eighteen on the closing date and be a current member of Queen's Students' Union (St Mary's and Stranmillis students are not eligible). Queen's Students' Union reserves the right to request proof of age and sight of a valid Queen's University student card.
8. The prize draw excludes permanent employees and their immediate families of Queen's Students Union, Queen's University Belfast, their agents or anyone professionally connected with this promotion.
9. Students of Queen's-INTO are not eligible to vote.
10. Votes from third parties or agents or incomplete votes will not be accepted. All votes must be made directly by the person entering the promotion.
